Annual Report for 2021

The Vidarbha Youth Welfare Society was established in the year 1965. The society established a Dental College and Hospital at Amravati in the year 1989 with capacity of 50 B.D.S. admission. and enjoy the privilege of being one of the first private dental college in state of Maharashtra. In 2011 Post graduation was started in 2 subject. and in 2017, institute added post graduation in 3 more subjects.

In 2020-21 the intake capacity of College increased from 50 to 100 B.D.S. admission as well as Ph. D. in 3 subjects was permitted by MUHS, Nashik.

The college was fully functional even with total lockdown in Amravati district from 15th February to 31st July as per direction of Local administration.

VYWS society directed Dental College to start 2 Covid-19 Vaccination center from 25th January 2021 in collaboration with Amravati Municipal Corporation which vaccinated around 50,000 Covid-19 vaccine.

In collaboration with District Hospital, a free covid diagnostic center was working in institute that tested around 1800 samples.

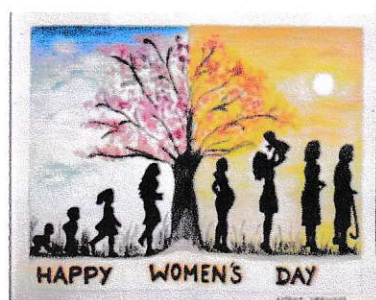

Inspite of on and off restrictions for covid 19 and allowed to treat Emergency & Urgent patient, the college was able to cater dental services to a total of 22166. This included 22101 OPD cases and 65 IPD cases.

Total of 815 patients attended were from BPL category with concession amounting for Rs 347010 was thus given to these BPL patients.

Total 353 patients were indigent patients who were given a concession of Rs 192605.
